

Reading plan to read the entire Scripture in one year

Hebrew year 5786 / Secular years 2025-2026

When a believer in the one true Creator-Living YAH and follower of His Son, Yeshua, discovers the *Torah* and begins to walk the Way of Truth, there are several ways to learn more about the Father's Character as they serve Him better. The route most people take is to study the weekly *parashot* (*Torah* portions) as law-abiding (orthodox) *Y'hudim* have been doing for many years, even before the birth of Yeshua. Although *Torah* has been neglected by most mainstream churches, it will not help much to study only *Torah* and neglect the rest of Scripture. This reading plan therefore follows the standard one-year *Torah* reading cycle in which each week is broken up into seven *aliyot* (plural of *aliyah*, "to come up") and the *haftarah* (departing, leaving) after the final *aliyah* on *Shabbat*. The rest of Scripture, however, is never touched upon and this is where this study plan tackles the rest of Scripture every day, except *Shabbat* and YAH's set-apart festival days. Even the Apostolic Scriptures, mistakenly known as the "new testament", are linked to the *Torah* portion weekly on *Shabbat*. Some exceptions, where other text is introduced, are explained later.

This is the tenth year in which we have had the privilege of publishing this reading plan. For the sixth time, we have once again retained the four recognised divisions of Scripture, namely *Torah*¹, *Nevi'im*², *K'tuvim*³, and Apostolic Writings⁴. This creates a more comfortable reading experience so that the serious student has more time to do in-depth studies. We have also added readings for the *`omer*-counting that begins on the day of the wave offering.

The dates on the far left are twofold: the first column contains the Hebrew (Scriptural) date indicating the day and month (day-month) in light blue; this is followed by the Gregorian date in black, for the sake of cross-reference, since we are currently illegally forced to use these secular systems. Dates in red indicate *Shabbat* and when *italicized* indicate feast days.

When does the new Scriptural year begin? YAH's year, which He commanded in *Sh'mot* 12:2, begins on the new moon within about 7 to 12 days before or after the spring equinox of the 'north'. Here in the 'south' it would therefore be the autumnal equinox. The month that begins with the new moon around the spring equinox (or autumn with us), is therefore month one. In Scripture it is also known as *Aviv*.

While there is much uncertainty about when the new moon occurs, we do not agree with the common belief that the new month begins with the first visible sliver or crescent of light after the dark moon. Our current belief is that a new month begins at the darkest part of the moon, i.e. at conjunction, when no light from the moon is visible and renewal occurs. By observing how the moon wanes, it is easier to determine when complete darkness will occur than to guess when the first sliver will appear. Scripture does not teach us that a new month is indicated by the first sliver of light on the moon⁵:

¹ The word '*Torah*' was incorrectly translated many years ago as 'law', but it actually means 'instructions' or 'rules'. It comprises the first five books of Scripture, also known as the Pentateuch, books attributed to *Mosheh*.

² *Nevi'im* is the plural of '*navi*', the Hebrew word that translates as 'prophet'.

³ *K'tuvim* is the Hebrew for "writings", which includes all poetic books of Scripture, such as *Tehilim*, *Mishle*, and the like, books that do not sort under *Torah* or *Nevi'im*.

⁴ We prefer this term instead of the misnomer "new testament." Scripture is one manual and should not be divided. This also causes division in the Body of our Messiah and Father's Kingdom.

⁵ This quote was constructed through artificial intelligence.

"The Bible does not explicitly state that a new month starts with the first sliver of the moon, but the Hebrew word for month, 'Hodesh' [חֹדֶשׁ (*Gô-desh*), is closely related to the New Moon. Some interpretations suggest that the New Moon is marked by the first visible crescent, as indicated in Exodus 12:2, where God instructs Moses about the beginning of months."

From the above quote, which also refers to other sources, it is clear that assumptions were made by rabbinic sages without confirmation in Scripture. The word *chodesh* refers to the "new moon" and also implies 'month', from which the latter derives. However, there is no mention of a sliver or a crescent in any translation – even King James. We may therefore not assume the right to place or replace something in Scripture (isogesis – in-reading) that is not there (cf. *Deuteronomy* 4:2; 12:32; *Mishle* 30:6; *Revelation* 22:18-19; *Mattityahu* 5:17-19). Although there are many arguments that would see the sliver or a shred of the moon as the 'new' moon, we will, for now, be content with our conviction. It is a pity that many people side with man-made rules and interpretations without solid conviction, rather than seeking the answer in Scripture. As with many other things, there will always be differences of opinion. We would therefore prefer to agree to disagree, than divide the Body of Messiah more than it is already.

Creation began in darkness and YAH made the first light (cf. *B'reisheet* 1:3), from which the rest subsequently arose and were created. An embryo is in darkness during a woman's pregnancy and only sees light after complete growth has occurred. A new day begins after the sun has set, in near darkness, therefore a new moon will also be dark. However, we only want to assure you that this is a personal belief and is not imposed on anyone. Each person has the right to differ from others. There is no salvation regarding this thought. More information is available in the article YAH's Calendar which is currently being revised and will be made available soon.

A full, colorful annual calendar of fourteen or fifteen months is sent out annually to interested parties. The calendar is divided according to the rules mentioned above and begins with the first month of Scripture, not the seventh, as in Rabbinic Judaism. The last month of the previous year and the first month of the following year overlap simply for continuity. The calendar contains each week's *Torah* portions, set-apart festival days, some of which are considered *Shabbat*, as well as various other information that may be important or interesting. It is also available on our website, [Silver Trumpet](#).

Believers who follow the Rabbinic calendar will realise that some feast days may not correspond with their calendar, since they use the calendar of *Hillel II* which is mathematically calculated in advance on a 19-year cycle and does not necessarily work strictly according to Scripture. While we will respectfully disagree with our brother, *Y'hudah*, we prefer to disagree with man rather than our Creator-*Elohim*. Various teachings regarding the determination of festival days are available upon request. This point of view does not mean that we do not consider other people's opinions or think that we are correct in everything. On the contrary, we are happy to listen to the opinion of others while it is substantiated from Scripture.

We are providing two reading plans: one with the original 'old' English names, as well as one with the (restored) Hebrew names. Most of the names in this reading plan are obvious, but for those who are not familiar with the Hebrew names or do not have a translation with corrected names:

B'reisheet = Genesis, *Sh'mot* = Exodus, *Vayiqra* = Leviticus, *B'midbar* = Numbers, *D'varim* = Deuteronomy, *Shof'tim* = Judges, *M'lakhim* = Kings, *Tz'faniyah* = Zephaniah, *Mizmor* = Psalm (singular), *Tehilim* = Psalms (the entire book), *Mishlei* = Proverbs, *Shir-HaShirim* = Song of Songs, *Eikhah* = Lamentations, *Qohelet* = Ecclesiastes, *Divrei-HaYamim* = Chronicles, *Mattityahu* = Matthew, *Yochanan* = John, *Kefa* = Peter, *Y'hudah* = Jude.

Some readers may notice that the order of the books is different from what we are used to, because this order is the same as the original Hebrew books, before Jerome changed it with his Latin Vulgate Bible. More information is available at <http://www.cogwriter.com/original-bible-order.htm>

For anyone who enjoys a fresh perspective, we would like to recommend the following two translations: [The Scriptures](#) translated by dr. Chris Koster, as well as the [CJB \(Complete Jewish Bible\)](#), translated by dr. David Stern. Both of these translations contain all the restored Hebrew names as well as invaluable information about YAH's set apart festival days. Both translations are also available as electronic versions for theWord (www.theword.net), a free application for Windows computers and certainly the best free application for Scripture study currently available. We also make each week's readings available for theWord in zip format and this is available on request, along with instructions for installing it.

Glossed text is to indicate the new month (cf. Mizmor 81 :3).

Green text is used to indicate non-Scriptural festivals that may have some value, but should be approached with great caution. Please read the explanation towards the end very carefully.

Red text is used to indicate *Shabbat*, both weekly and special *Shabbatot* during special holidays. Some people may not have a colour printer or electronic device with colour, so we suggest that the lighter (red) text be noted with a coloured highlighter.

All *italicized text* on the study plan are readings for specific set-apart festivals during the secular years 2025/2026 :

- 🏆 *Pesach* is from sunset 31 March to sunset 1 April and is only a day of preparation, similar to day 6 (friday), a regular workday and not *Shabbat* (cf. *Vayiqra* 23:5)
- 🏆 The first day of **Unleavened Bread** is from sunset 1 April to sunset 2 April and is considered as **Shabbat**. (cf. *Leviticus* 23:7)
- 🏆 Wave offering begins at sunset 4 April to sunset 5 April (cf. *Vayiqra* 23:11); this is also the day on which the `omer count begins (cf. *Vayiqra* 23:15), but because the change of day occurs at sunset, the `omer count already begins already on the evening of 4 April, **after** sunset
- 🏆 From sunset 7 April to sunset 8 April is the **end of Pesach/Unleavened Bread** and is once again considered as a **Shabbat**. (cf. *Vayiqra* 23:8b)
- 🏆 **Shavu'ot** is from sunset 23 May to sunset 24 May and is celebrated as **Shabbat**. (cf. *Leviticus* 23:21)
- 🏆 **Yom T'ruah** is from sunset 10 September to sunset 11 September and is celebrated as **Shabbat**. (cf. *Leviticus* 23:24-25)
- 🏆 **Yom Kipur** is from sunset 19 September to sunset 20 September and is **Shabbat** (cf. *Leviticus* 23:26-32)
- 🏆 **Sucot** takes place from sunset 24 September to sunset 1 October (cf. *Vayiqra* 23:34-43). The first day is a **Shabbat**. With the exception of the weekly **Shabbat**, the other days in between are normal days, until the end of the set-apart festival at sunset on 1 October.
- 🏆 **Simchat Torah** is from sunset 1 October to sunset 2 October, along with **Sh'mini atzeret**. This word translates as "eighth gathering." Although this festival day is part of the set apart feasts, we only read about it later in *Vayiqra* 23:26. It is a joyful gesture of gratitude that concludes the old *Torah* cycle and welcomes in the new *Torah* cycle. The final *Torah* portion, *V'zot haBrachah* (this is the blessing) is usually read during the week of this set-apart festival.

The book of *Ruth* is traditionally read during *Shavu'ot* and is therefore indicated as such in italics. For this reason, the book of *Qohelet* (Ecclesiastes) is interrupted. Although *Purim* is not a Scriptural festival, it is customary to read the book of *Esther* during this time. Therefore, the book of *Mishlei* (Proverbs) is interrupted during this period. Two festivals are not mentioned in Scripture and are therefore not obligatory for non-Y'hudim to celebrate:

- 🥂 *Purim* during the Hebrew month of *Adar* or *VeAdar* (also *Adar II*, usually March/April)
- 🥂 *Chanukah*, the festival of rededication, during the Hebrew month of *Kislev* (usually November/December)

However, should anyone feel the need to participate in these festivals in any way, please carefully study the origins and customs surrounding these festivals to ensure that one pagan tradition (christmas *et al*) is not exchanged for other pagan traditions, including unscriptural Jewish festivals.

During some of the set-apart festivals, entire chapters of various books are read. Therefore, when it appears that some chapters have been omitted from the study plan, they will be found among the readings for the set-apart festivals. This includes especially the last chapters of the four *b'sorot* (gospels) as well as some of the prophets. In order to fit everything in, some prophets may be found under the heading of *Torah*. These are exceptional and are simply placed in this way to organise the list so as not to take up unnecessary space.

Some names may differ from what other writers use. We only use phonetic text transliteration directly from Hebrew to English, therefore, for example, we will spell the last festival, *Sucot*, and not *Sukkot* as many other writers and institutions do. This is in line with guidelines in "The SBL handbook of style".

While every precaution has been taken against errors, minor human errors may have crept in. Please do not hesitate to let us know if you find any errors in the reading plan – spelling errors, dates and the like – so that we can correct them in future editions. If any links do not work, please notify us as soon as possible.

May every person who uses this reading plan be blessed to revel in the fullness and joy of Father's Word, while at the same time learn to walk more carefully in the footsteps of our Messiah, *Yeshua*.
